Dear Mr. Slease:

We are sending to you two computer mainframes for FCC Part-15, subpart J, class B qualification testing. One computer is a cost reduced model 800 which is to be tested with joysticks and the 810 Disk Drive presently in your possession. Since it is cost reduced, we expect radiated levels to be in excess of Type I TV Device limits but under Class B levels. The cost reduced version features 48K RAM cards permanently placed and sealed and is the main difference over previous 800's.

The second unit is the Atari 1200 computer which represents a new entry for the Home Computer Division. It also is to be tested with Joysticks and the 810 Disk Drive. This unit is a prototype but is indicative of production electrically and mechanically. It is submitted to you in strict confidence and we are sure confidentiality will be maintained by Electro-Service Corporation.

Atari, Home Computer Division, will also favor Electro Services Corporation to personally transport both computers and test reports to the FCC offices for purposes of certification. Per your correspondence, this will expedite more timely approval by the Commission. You are authorized to utilize the open Purchase Order for this special handling cost.

Additionally, we are formally requesting that either Jamie Cook or myself personally review each and every written correspondence Electro-Services Corporation may make to the Commission on behalf of Atari, Home Computer Division, prior to submittal. This is to insure we all know exactly what is being asked of the FCC.
